LEADERSHIP

BELA Program

The Blacktown Emerging Leaders & Advocates (BELA) Program provides aspiring young leaders in the community with the opportunity to work alongside mentors to develop leadership skills.

EMPLOYMENT

Certificate Training

Through our networks and partnerships we offer free and subsidized certificate training programs to eligible clients.

Clients will be engaged with multiple services for 6-12 weeks and will receive a TAFE NSW certificate upon completion.

School to Work

The School to Work program assists young people in preparing for employment. Each week the program covers important topics, such as interview skills & attire.

Clients are also given help in preparing their resume & cover letter, and are given information about current job opportunities.
